- Rules – Hand out and review highlights
- Carry the rules sheet with you to show the umpire if there is a question.
- 8U stealing is allowed.
- 8U coach pitch for 1st part of season only.
- Feb 12th ASA Coaches clinic in Downey. Questions contact Division Reps or print a flyer at www.socal-asa.com
- Rescheduling of games procedure – you have hand out
- What is rostered staff: Manager, 2 coaches, chaperone. Application must be submitted, approved by the board. These are the only people allowed on the field for games. Unrostered practice coaches can be unlimited.
- Bathroom Duty at Middle school: The last scheduled game of the day; both managers are responsible to pick up the bathrooms.
- Field Maintenance – Proper training / home team's responsibility also the removable pitchers plate and bases are home teams responsibility. Training session Feb 11th 8am- 9am at Middle school. Please send at least one person from your team. It can be a parent.
*Mandatory for 8U is the pitching machine demo same time as field maintenance meeting.
- Managers/staff are responsible for the parents and their staff's behavior.
- Practice days – you'll get the next practice schedule after game schedule is issued, Field locations R1, R3, etc... Understand the 45 mins to an hour on the dirt.
- Field Condition Hotline: 524-2883 – Updated after 2pm
- Field Allocation Policy – 3 strikes rule - \$100 fine – If there is a consistent problem with your team, manager will be removed.
- Lights – Call Rec park – 524-2700 – Notify rep if lights are delayed.
- If your not going to use your field time, let your Division rep know 24 hours in advance by e-mail AND Phone call.
- Pitching Machine-use and care. There is one in each shed. We have a stand to roll it out. No kids allowed to operate. R2 has priority. Return it the way you found it. Standing up!
- Sliding Mats. – No shoes or cleats on mat.
- Equipment (esp. balls) belong to league / game balls. Label them. No more snack bar storage – everything is in sheds.
- Chin straps – mandatory by ASA rules.
- Facemasks – mandatory by ASA rules – not 6U
- Try to have a female present at practice/games

- E-mail roster sheets and hand in all manager/team handouts to division rep by: Feb 5th – Please be careful on spelling of names and correct phone numbers! – Feelings get hurt!
- Opening day is 6pm Feb 24th - game is at 7pm
- The Parade is Saturday morning Feb 25th 10am - Line up at 9:30am in upper parking lot. Rose Ragan is in charge of line up for parade.
- Parade procedure - 6u first line up teams 1-6 then 8U, 10U, 12U, 14U, etc. All teams must be represented!
- Roster books with game schedule inside, handed out opening day
- Picture day is: March 18th - please inform parents of date!
- Sponsors banners must be hung up Every Game! Manager is responsible for banner. We are losing too many!
- Team parent meeting is Feb 21st 7pm for 8U& 6U and Feb 22nd – 7pm for 10U, 12U & 14U– need team parents - Snack Bar Schedule, Fundraiser, Pictures – Meeting is at the Snack Bar!
- No alcohol consumption during practices/games
