Registration Information

Returning players have the option of registering by mail or walk-in registration.

What is necessary to register?

- 1) Player Registration Form – Fill out form completely and sign before submitting
Parent's/Guardian's signature on the Registration Form confirms that you have read and agreed to the following policies:
 - a) Snack Bar Policy (Snack bar duty is typically a 5-6 hour commitment.)
 - b) Field Clean-Up Policy
 - c) Code of Ethics
- 2) Fees - Two (2) checks made payable to ESGS:
 - a) Check 1: the Registration Fees; also add optional Fundraiser Buy Out and Player Clinic Fees, if applicable.
 - b) Check 2: \$75 (per player) for your snack bar deposit.
- 3) **Copy** of player's birth certificate, if registering new player(s) to the League.
- 4) Player Clinic form – if your daughter plans on attending the player clinic on Saturday, January 31, 2010.
- 5) Volunteer form – If you would like to manage, coach or chaperone.

* **Late Registration** – If you register after January 6, 2010, registration fees increase to \$100 per player.

** **Snack Bar Deposit** – checks will not be cashed unless snack bar duty is not fulfilled. Please write a separate check for this amount. All other fees can be on one check. Make all checks payable to ESGS.

Player Evaluations – All players in 8U, 10U & 12U divisions are required to attend the player evaluations which will be held in January 2010, (dates, TBD). There may be no evaluations for the 14U Division if we will only be fielding one team (determined by number of girls who register in this division). Player evaluations are conducted for all the managers and coaches to have the opportunity to see the girls and evaluate them. This process helps to ensure balanced teams
