ESGS provides each player with a team jersey and matching socks. Team coaches will have softballs and league-provided bats and catcher's gear. Below is a list of gear that each player should have as well as optional equipment.

Uniform	Players will need to buy their own black softball pants or shorts. Sliding shorts worn under the pants or sliding pads for knees are optional but recommended.			
Cleats	Softball/baseball cleats should be worn, molded cleats only - no metal cleats. Optionally, soccer cleats can be worn, but softball/baseball cleats are recommended because they are made to help with traction while base running on the dirt.			
Batting Gloves	Good for protecting hands while batting and when sliding. Optional but recommended.			
Defensive Mask	Often seen being worn by pitchers and other infielders. Not required but use of a defensive mask is up to each player or parent			
Catcher's equipment	Coaches should have league-provided catcher's gear for players who want to catch. If catching becomes a primary postion for a player, parents may opt to purchase their own equipment.			
Face masks for helmets	Per Amateur Softball Association rules, the face guard is required as part of the batting helmet for divisions 8U and older
